## By age 3 years cannot:

- Be understood by family and/or caregivers
- Correctly produce vowels and such sounds as $\mathrm{p}, \mathrm{b}, \mathrm{m}, \mathrm{w}$ in words
- Repeat when not understood without becoming frustrated


## By age 4 years cannot:

- Be understood by individuals with whom they do not :
- Be understood by family and/or caregivers
- Correctly produce t, d, k, g, f
- Be asked to repeat without becoming sensitive


## By age 5 years cannot:

- Be understood in all situations by most listeners
- Correctly produce most speech sounds
- Be asked to repeat without exhibiting frustration
